Jackson County Executive Mike Sanders to speak July 26th

Our speaker at our July 26th meeting will be Mike Sanders. Sanders has served as the Jackson County Executive since 2007.

Previous to that, he was elected Jackson County Prosecutor from 2002-2006. Since taking office as County Executive in January 2007, he has worked to fundamentally change the way Jackson County Government operates on a daily basis.

Mike and his administration have limited the authority of the Executive branch and worked toward comprehensive eth-

ics reform. Additionally, he has demanded that the county live within its economic means by working within balanced budgets and stressed the importance of regional collaboration.

Mike's leadership has not gone unrecognized. The Aspen Institute, an international non-profit organization based in Washington D.C., selected him as a 2008 fellow in its national Rodel Fellowships in Public Leadership program. He also served as an officer in the United States Army.



It may seem a little odd to be getting the 2014 budget message in July, however, in the future the next year's budget will be approved in November and published in the January newsletter. I believe income and expense transparency is very important for any organization. These are your funds which you have entrusted to us to spend wisely. In order to balance the budget and avoid dipping into our reserves, cuts were made in a number of areas without adversely impacting programs. Our largest expenses that offer the greatest potential for reduction are printing and postage. Most of

these expenses relate to printing and mailing the newsletter. We are beginning the process of mailing printed copy only to those members who do not have email. There will also continue to be a link to the monthly newsletter on the



newsletter on the Chapter Web site at www.moaahoa.org.

It is important to note that most of our income is from dues paid by members each year. If you haven't already done so for 2014, it would be greatly appreciated if you would use the form on the back of this newsletter and mail your \$15 check to Vic Christiansen. We currently have 250 paid members and need 350 to balance the budget. This represents a budget shortfall of \$1500.

We also have savings in several accounts which we maintain to keep the Chapter in a healthy financial condition. If we continue to dip into them due to budget shortfalls each year, they will continue to be depleted to an unacceptably low level. We currently have approximately \$28,000 in four CD/Money Market accounts with USAA.
