# Meghan C. Voorhees (LCSW) is Speaker at October 28 Meeting

Our speaker at the October 28th luncheon meeing will be Meghan C. Voorhees. She will be telling us about Operation S.A.V.E.. This is a training program designed by the Department of Veterans Affairs to provide various audiences with knowledge and skills to identify those at risk for suicide and to respond appropriately. We will learn about the scope of suicide among the veteran population, how to identify when someone may be at risk for suicide. how to ask questions about suicide in an objective and non-threatening way, and how to help an individual access evaluation and treatment.

Meghan C. Voorhees is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in Missouri. She earned undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Missouri-St. Louis. Since 2013, Meghan has worked for the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as part of the suicide prevention program.

Our Meeting will be held October 28, 2017 (4th Saturday) at the new DAV (Disabled American Veterans) building at 14605 East Hwy 40, Kansas City, MO 64136. The Auxiliary Luncheon begins at 1145 hours with the MOAA Luncheon beginning at 1215 hours. Cost of the lunch is \$12.00.
