Representative From The Veterans Community Project Is Our May 18th Speaker

Veterans Community Project

The speaker for our May 2019 luncheon meeting will be from the Veterans Community Project (VCP). The motto of this organization is "One Homeless Veteran Is One Too Many". There are currently over 40,000 veterans experiencing homelessness. The VCP has created an innovative solution providing transitional housing and access to 360-degree solutions with the goal of eliminating Veteran Homelessness nationwide. In contrast to traditional homeless services, VCP provides privacy and security through a tiny home. The combination of stable, dignified housing and onsite services enable Veterans to establish a sense of independence and security that will facilitate transition to permanent housing. A list of onsite services includes independent living skills, Mental/Physical therapy, assistance with disabilities and substance abuse counselling and treatment, Legal & Advocacy assistance with case management and general advocacy and other services such as employment counselling and transition services. Some 800 cities nationwide are looking into implementing the same model established here in Kansas City. The VCP is made possible through public-private partnerships and individual and corporate donations.

Our Meeting will be held May 18th, 2019 (3rd Saturday) at the DAV (Disabled American Veterans) building at 14605 East Hwy 40, Kansas City, MO 64136. The Auxiliary Luncheon begins at 1145 hours with the MOAA Luncheon beginning at 1215 hours. Cost of the lunch is \$12.00.

To get to the DAV from Independence, Missouri, exit off I-70 onto Noland to go south for 1 mile to E Hwy 40. Turn left and drive one-half-mile. DAV is on the south side of East Hwy 40.

Everyone must have a meal reservation by Monday, May13th. If you are on the permanent list, you need call only if you are not attending.

Substitute meals must be requested at time of reservation. Cancellations must be called in by 9:00 a.m. Saturday of the luncheon.
