Jack Cashill will talk about how our media lost their way

Jack Cashill is an independent writer and producer and, on a contractual basis, the Executive Editor of Ingram's Magazine. In addition to his work with Ingram's, Jack has written for Fortune, The Wall Street Journal, The Washington Post, The Weekly Standard, American-Thinker.com, and regularly for WorldNetDaily. He was born and raised in Newark, New Jersey and received his Ph.D. in American Studies from Purdue University in 1982. He has taught media and literature at Purdue and at universities in the Kansas City area. He served as a Fulbright professor in Nancy, France. He will address how a generation ago journalists prided themselves on their objectivity and lack of partisanship. Now, from the New York Times to Google News, they are expected to honor a party line. This means ignoring some stories and hounding others, even if they go nowhere. Jack will talk about a pair of recent projects in which he has been involved that show how far the media have gone astray.
