# Mel Carney, Vietnam Combat Veteran, To Speak About His Book "Command At Dawn""



Mel Carney was an Army Infantry Officer in Viet Nam. He arrived in country on Feb 4, 1968 and served as a platoon leader and then as a company commander in the field for six to seven months. He earned the Army Combat Infantry Badge, and was awarded a Purple Heart. His unit received a Valorous Unit Award. He spent the last few months in Chu Lai as an operations officer for the Chu Lai Defense Command. He completed his tour on February 4, 1969. In November of 2019, he published the book, **Command At Dawn**. The story is about command and leadership. He was in the field during the second Tet Offensive which started on May 5, 1968. On that day, the NVA struck 119 times the length of South Vietnam. Before June 1st, his company went from 115 men to 79 and on June 1st, they were hit with a massive mortar barrage. The book covers this battle and the impact that military training

and accepting responsibility had on the outcome. Mel has dedicated himself, and Command **At Dawn**, to helping veterans communicate better with their families and friends. The more the family knows about what their veteran has been through, the better that they will know their veteran. Mel only wishes that his fellow veterans not leave the legacy:

"Dad never talked about the war."
